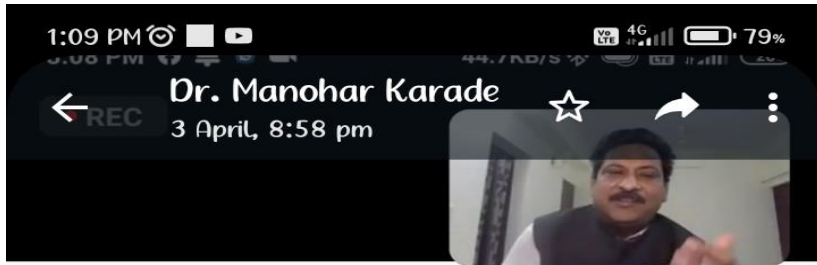
### Highlights:

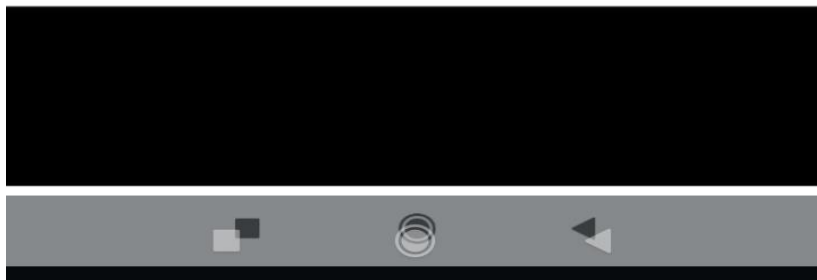

- The basic idea in mixed methods research is that we want to use quantitative and qualitative methods together to get a complete understanding of the phenomenon we are studying.
- Researchers using this approach collect, analyze and combine qualitative and quantitative data into a single study.
- They usually have two objectives that, at some stage, they bring together and integrate in other words, in a mixed methods approach, we combine together the power of quantitative data (the numbers) with qualitative data to give our findings better context.

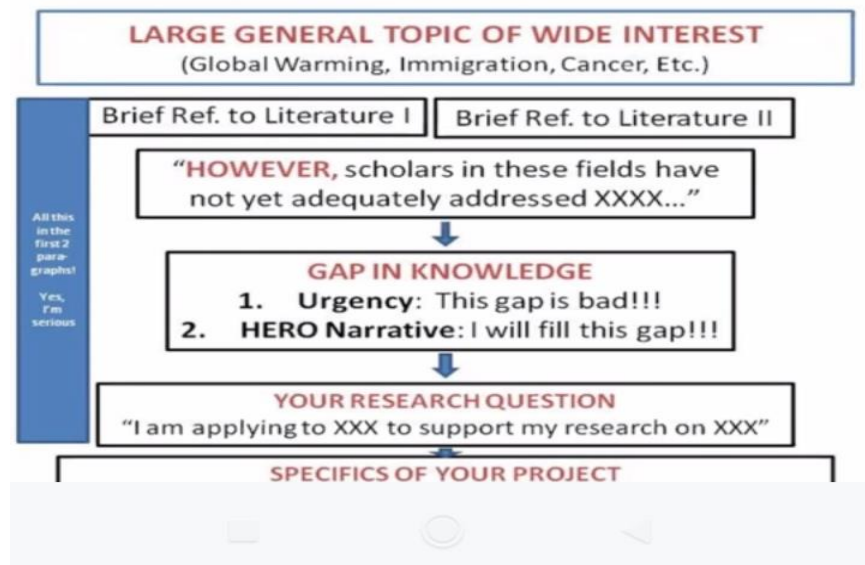
