The students of JSIMR celebrated Ambedkar Jayanti with much enthusiasm and shed light on Dr.





Human Rights and Duties Education Programme

To be commenced from 2011-2012

Introduction

In response to the initiative of the Human Rights Commission of the State of Maharashtra's proposal to start Human Rights Education in the State of Maharashtra, it has organized a one day State Level Seminar on Human Rights Education on August12, 2010 in Mumbai. During the Presentation of the proposal of the University of Pune, the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of the University declared that the University of Pune will introduce a Human Rights Education Awareness Programme in the University from the Academic Year 2011-2012 which will be compulsory to all the students of the Post Graduation in the University later to extend to colleges in the University area. Accordingly, the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor constituted a committee on November 10, 2010 to discuss the modalities.

Objective's of the Programme.

In response to the call given by the UN to states parties to take steps to propagate the ideals of the Human Rights Education to develop a citizen friendly value based society both nationally and internationally, the Government of India being a party to the various declarations and other legal instruments constituted a number of committees to draw independent plans. In response to the call of the National Human Rights Commission in 1999, the UGC adopted a model curriculum to be adopted by various Universities in the country with an aim to promote the Human Rights Education.

To equip the students of the University of Pune as future citizens of the State and the Country, in discharging their duties before exercising their rights, the University authorities have taken the decision to implement the Human Rights Education in its Post Graduate Programme across the board with a uniform syllabi and pattern. Accordingly, it has been decided to have four papers in each semester of 2 credits each for all the students apart from their regular credits. Taking into consideration of varied disciplines, it has been decided that the course content should be general in nature to make it easy and attractive covering various aspects of Human Rights Education. The available models and other aspects will be consulted to draw a final syllabus. The course will be taught in a basic perspective with the help of cartoons, figure and question answer modules for easy understanding. The available materials may be incorporated or new ones may be prepared. Once the Committee finalises the materials and course, it will be placed before the respective bodies of the University for its Implementation. The new teaching techniques of ematerial and or any other suitable pattern may be adopted.

Course Objectives: This course introduces students to the Constitution of India. The Constitution, being supreme law of the land, must be known to every citizen of India. It begins with the Preamble, which indicates the source and objects of it. We, the people of India, are the source of the Constitution and have resolved to constitute India into a sovereign, socialist, secular, democratic and republic. The Course has been designed for everyone to make acquaint themselves with their fundamental rights and of others. No right is absolute one; it is subject to others right, as well. Directive Principles of State Policy are nothing but rights, though not enforceable by any court. These Directive Principles are basically 'Fundamental Principles' in the governance of the country. Powers and freedoms come with responsibility, State's responsibility to implement Directive Principles and citizens must perform their duties towards others, society and nation.
